History: Miss Jessie Cameron worked with a whisky firm in Charles Street, and presented this trophy, suggesting it be the Handicap Trophy for the Championship (The Lord Provost's Trophy was for the scratch winner.) However, it appears to have become a separate competition in its own right, with the first winner being noted in 1966.

Competition: 2 rounds strokeplay
