History:

One of the earliest trophies, this was originally presented in 1931 for a putting competition. The donor, Thomas Ross was connected to MacGregor and Co, Goldsmith and Jewellers. It was won in 1931 by Miss Jenny Kilgour, (see Kilgour Inkstand), and she seems to have kept it. After her death, her family returned it to the club, and it has since been used as a cup played for by Senior members of the club.
